## BAPTISMS

All Baptisms to be held at St. Charles Borromeo are to be scheduled through the administrative office. Parents are required to attend a pre-Baptism class, preferably before the birth of the baby. **Classes are held quarterly (Jan., Apr., July & Oct.) on the third Monday of the month at 7:00 p.m.** Parents must be registered and practicing the Catholic faith. Parents not married in the church must meet with the acting priest of the parish to discuss the validation of their marriage. Godparents should be Catholic, fully initiated (i.e. Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation), 16 years or older and live a life of faith in harmony with the duty being undertaken. Baptisms are held on the fourth Sunday of the month unless special arrangements have been made through the administrative office.

## WEDDINGS

All weddings to be held at St. Charles Borromeo are to be scheduled through the administrative office and must be made at least 6 months in advance of the wedding date. **THIS IS A DIOCESAN REQUIREMENT.** Every couple must attend a pre-marriage preparation weekend retreat or class and meet with the St. Charles Borromeo wedding coordinators. Any fees to be paid for church, parish hall use, etc., are to be paid at the office.

## FUNERALS

All funerals and memorials to be held at St. Charles Borromeo are to be scheduled through the office. Please call the office to make an appointment with the funeral coordinator.
